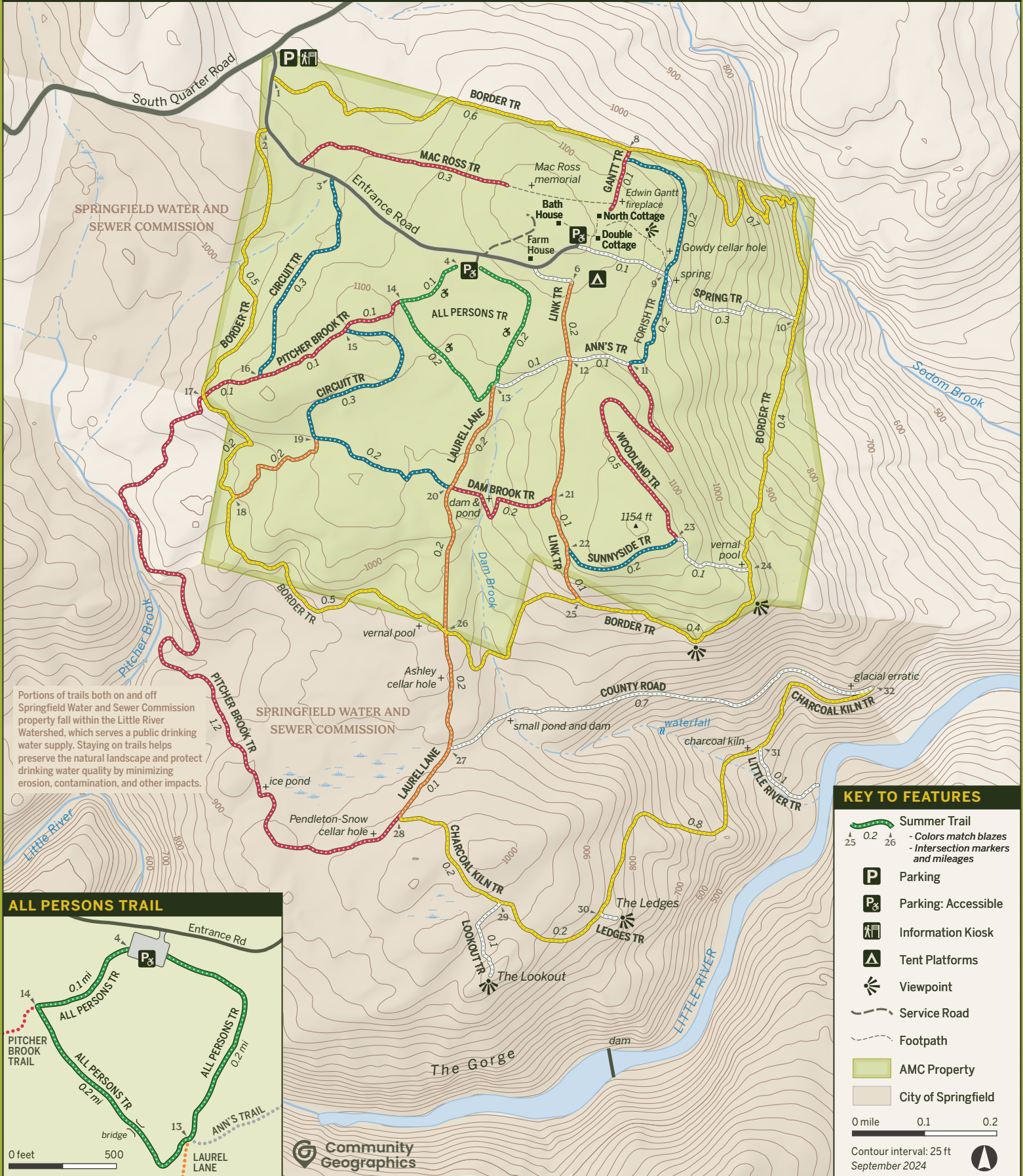




NOBLE VIEW OUTDOOR CENTER

Noble View Summer Trails



Portions of trails both on and off Springfield Water and Sewer Commission property fall within the Little River Watershed, which serves a public drinking water supply. Staying on trails helps preserve the natural landscape and protect drinking water quality by minimizing erosion, contamination, and other impacts.
